



## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

#### Kia Ora

The Year 6 Leadership Camp was held last Thursday and Friday at Camp Iona. The weather was amazing and so were the students!! All of them gave everything their all and certainly showed that each and everyone of them has leadership potential. Thank you to the parents who attended the camp, as this could not have gone ahead without them. I would also like to acknowledge the planning and organisation Mrs Barrow and Mr Fry undertook to make it so successful. Their end of year camp will be held at Waihola in November.

Ngā Manu (Senior) Innovative Learning Environment - Today is shifting day for Ruru, Piwakawaka and Toroa as the building work in the Ngā Manu classrooms commences on Monday. This is expected to take 10 weeks to complete and plans can be viewed in the Office area. This is a significant build but we have looked at ways to keep disruption to a minimum. As reported earlier, Piwakawaka and Ruru will combine together and teach out of the hall. This space is effectively a double classroom and will be set up effectively to house all of the children. Toroa will teach within Room 2, as the New-Entrants will continue to be taught in Room 3 by Mrs King and Mrs Stevenson during this time. Programmes will continue to be taught as per usual from Monday onwards and I know the students will make these spaces their own in the short-term. The builders will be accessing the site from Mathieson Street so there will be no vehicles etc on school grounds during the build. Just be aware that this will mean there will be less parking outside the school in this area.

I would like to thank all of the parents and children who are utilising the two road crossings that are run at the end of the school day, Belford/Mathieson Streets and Larnach Road.
