PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Kia ora koutou

Our 'What's the Buzz?" parent interviews concluded yesterday afternoon and I would like to thank all of those who look the opportunity to attend these. This was a wonderful opportunity to discuss your child and share with their teacher important information which will assist them throughout the year. One of the Board's Strategic Aims is to "to continue to enhance and nurture positive relationships with whānau" with an aspirational outcome of "increasing whānau/caregiver participation in parent interviews aiming for 100%." Approximately 83% of our parents/caregivers took this opportunity. If you were not able to make a time, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher and make a time that is mutually suitable.

On Tuesday, I accompanied Mrs Stevenson and the ten <u>P.A.L's (Physical Activity Leaders)</u> to a training day held at the Edgar Centre. As always, our students shone and were incredible ambassadors for our school. They will be able to utilise what they have learnt to run wonderful games and activities for our students and practice and develop their leadership skills.

This Friday we will be holding <u>House Leader Elections</u>. A number of Year 6 students are putting their hand up for these coveted positions and two people will be elected for each House Group, one as Captain and the other Vice-Captain. I look forward to announcing 2018 House Leaders in next week's newsletter.

Tonight is the <u>PTA's Annual General Meeting</u>, and their first meeting of the year will be held afterwards. All executive positions will be elected at the AGM. <u>Please come along and show your support</u> to this vital group who raise much needed money for the school, supporting of your children's educational success.

Property Information

The Board of Trustees (BoT) are required to create a 10 Year Property Plan (10YPP) which prioritizes all Health and Safety issues, then any upgrades to buildings. From there, the Ministry of Education (MoE) and the BoT create a 5 Year Property Plan (5YA) which itemizes the work that will be undertaken in the next 5 years. The BoT is supported by Jamie Lyons, Property Manager from Signature Property to create these documents and run projects. The amount of property money that the MoE allocate our school to complete these projects is based on the number of children on our roll. It is important to note that the MoE does not allow these funds to be used for playground development. It is also important to understand that the BoT has had to use the school's financial reserves to build an 11th classroom (Summer 2017) and top up the Nga Manu (senior) block redevelopment, which is currently underway. Each project goes out for tender and the contract is awarded based on price, timing etc. As the construction company who was awarded the Nga Manu project was unable to undertake the project throughout the January school holidays, the BoT negotiated the timing, asking for the work within the Te Ngahere (Middle Syndicate) classrooms be done in the summer break and then starting the major work early in the first term. As stated previously, this project is expected to take ten weeks and the students will hopefully be able to use these spaces from the start of Term 2.

The MoE also has funding available for special projects to support students to fully access all aspects of their school. This funding is above what is allocated to the school and does not affect the 10YPP or 5YA. The accessible toilet (2015), extension to the Nga Manu verandah (2017) and ramps to the top field (2018) have all been funded through this and have not only benefited our students with special needs but also all of our students. The BoT, with the help of Sonya Power, have applied to funding agencies to access much needed funds to assist with the playground redevelopment. As this is a large project and we are unable to access MoE money for this, these funds will be combined with the 2017 fair proceeds to start the upgrade as soon as possible. If you have any further questions around our property plans or current redevelopment, please do not hesitate to contact me.
