


OUR "IT NINJAS"

There is now a <u>NEW</u> format for ordering Sausages (\$2.00) and Ice Blocks (\$1.00) - we're sure you will love not having to find the cash to accompany your childrens' orders!!!! We are using the Kindo System for these orders and it is really very easy to use! We have had a lot of positive feedback from parents who are paying for items this way. It is important you note there will be NO cash orders, and no forms going home with the return slip included.

For <u>existing KINDO users</u>, all you need to do is copy and paste the following link into your browser,

https://shop.tgcl.co.nz/shop/q2.shtml?session=false&shop=Grant%27s%20Braes%20School and then log in using the email address the school has on file for you, and follow through the prompts. The main thing to note is you need to 'top up' your account by transferring the appropriate amount of funds, i.e. \$3.00 for one sausage and one ice block, and then allocate this at the checkout.

For <u>new users</u>, all you need to do is copy and paste the following link into your browser to register.

Make sure you are <u>using the email address the school has on file for you, and you are also</u>
<u>logged in on this email account when ordering/paying.</u> See above paragraph re 'topping up'
your account.

The KINDO site is **now open** for sausage sizzle orders to be placed, and it will **close for orders at 4.00pm on Tuesday, 6th March.**

Using this new ordering system will not affect how children receive their sausages and ice blocks. Children will still go to the PTA representatives outside the hall for their sausages, and to the 'old Dental Clinic' for their ice block.

For any assistance re using KINDO, please contact their Help Desk on Freephone 0508 4 KINDO (0508 454 636) - the Help Desk people are very nice and helpful. They are open from 8.00am - 4.00pm.


