

Hei kona mai I roto I ngā mihi, Goodbye for now and thanks. GARETH TAYLOR, PRINCIPAL


















CHILDREN'S SAFETY




Congratulations to the Mystics Netball Team who came 3rd in their Grade, and thanks also to the awesome Tammy for coaching both this team, and the Magic Team.
