# PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

#### Kia ora koutou

Many teachers have spoken to me on how lovely it is seeing older siblings looking after their younger brothers and sisters when they come into, or are leaving the school grounds. This shows our school value of E Kumanu Ana - We Care so strongly. Once again, I thank you for your patience at this time and I am really appreciative of you all ensuring that you are following the school's Alert Level 2 procedures.

I was delighted to hear the wonderful news that Teacher Aides; - Learning Assistants in our case, have the opportunity to vote on a significant pay increase. Learning Assistants do an incredible job supporting students in a myriad of ways and are a key component of our student's success at school. This is such welcome news and a start to ensure that they are recognised for the important role they play.

#### Ministry of Education Teacher Only Day

In 2019. our teachers accepted the pay offer from the Ministry of Education (MoE) which resulted in them settling the negotiations and accepting new terms for the 2019-2022 Primary Teachers' Collective Agreement. As part of the terms agreed to, the Ministry of Education has provided eight additional Teacher Only Days to help address teacher workload. These allocated eight MoE Teacher Only Days are required to be taken within the duration of the three-year Collective Agreement.

At the February Board of Trustees Meeting, the use of one of these MoE Teacher Only Days was approved so that teachers could be released to write mid-year reports. As reported earlier, there will be no Mid-Year reports or interviews in Term 2 due to the Covid-19 situation, but we will share a more detailed plan on how we report to whānau in due course. As a result of this, we have decided to change the focus of this planned MoE Teacher Only Day to School-wide Planning and Reporting. The Board of Trustees has approved the changed date and our school will be closed on Monday 29 June for this reason. A plan to use the remainder of the days will also be developed, discussed at Board level, and communicated as soon as possible with our whānau. Thank you for your support and co-operation.

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Hockey information was sent out to all families by email on Monday of this week, and it is repeated here. Please note that the closing date for hockey registrations is 3.00pm next Tuesday, 2 June and all registrations must be made using KINDO. There will be NO LATE Registrations as Jen Stevenson has a very tight timetable to keep for getting the registrations into the Otago Hockey Association.



The Otago Hockey Association has been working on their formats to come up with a modified Hockey competition for this season. Please read the following information and register your **YEAR 3-6** child through Kindo if they are interested in playing Hockey for Grant's Braes School this season.

For **Year 1-2 children** interested in playing, please refer to the **poster on Page 4 of this newsletter.**Please note - more information in regards to the Covid-19 protocols will be shared once our teams have been registered.

Registrations close on <u>TUESDAY 2nd JUNE</u> - you must register <u>via Kindo by 3pm on Tuesday 2nd June</u>. The modified Hockey competition is being run on a Wednesday afternoon between 3.40-6.30pm for Mini Sticks (Y3/4) and Kiwi Sticks (Y5/6) at the McMillan Hockey Turf in Harbour Terrace. <u>Hockey will start on Wednesday 17th June</u>, break for School Holidays and then run for all of Term 3 with competition finishing on the 25th of September (13 weeks total).

<u>Ministicks Year 3/4</u> - 'Train and Play' concept. This involves splitting into smaller groups and working on smaller playing fields with Otago Hockey Association coaches out on the turf working to develop the players skills through engagement while also helping to support our coaches/ teachers/ parent volunteers.

<u>Kiwisticks Year 5/6</u> - games played on 1/4 of the field.

Children will need to wear their sports uniforms, shin pads and a mouthguard. We can lend hockey sticks if your child needs one. It can get very cold at the turf, so dress warmly!

OHA has asked that we enter teams of 8-9 players. If we do not have enough players to enter a team, I can pass your details onto OHA and the children may be able to join another school's team.

The cost will depend on the number of children playing, but will cost approximately \$35-\$45.

We require parents to coach and umpire these teams.
