Kia ora koutou Another quick message from me today, and I hope that you all had a lovely long weekend!

I would like to remind parents and caregivers that due to <u>extreme adverse weather</u> conditions, the school may start later in the morning, or a decision is made for all schools not to open at all. This decision is not made lightly and a number of representatives from the Otago Primary Principals' Association, after consultation with police and other agencies, make this decision for all primary schools. This is made in the best interests of safety for all. In these instances, we will contact you as soon as possible via text message and email, but please also listen to 97.4 More FM if you believe the school may be affected in this way. Also, with the colder weather, a lot more illnesses will be around, therefore it is timely to remind you to please keep your children home while they are unwell. Children do not concentrate or learn well when they are sick, and so resting them at home is the best option for them. This will also help minimise the 'passing on' of these bugs to other children or staff. Please note if your child has a vomiting or diarrhoea bug, they are to be away from school for at least a further 24 hours from the last event.

<u>Exciting news!</u> Our <u>two EPRO8 teams have made it to the finals</u>, to be held next Tuesday at Dunedin North intermediate. Our school also featured on Channel 39 with Austin and Mrs McKeever being interviewed. 


