School Drop Offs and Pick Ups

It is important that children are at school and settled in **before 9am each day.** Also - especially for our younger children, **please be at school by 3.00pm to collect them.** Our teachers often have to be away to meetings shortly after the bell rings, and are unable to supervise children in their classes, so it is important that parents/caregivers are at school on time for pick-up.

School Absences

If your child is away from school due to being unwell, for an appointment, or you are out of town, please always ring and leave a message on the school phone, or send an email to your class teacher with the office@grantsbraes.school.nz email included also (in case the class teacher is sick, on a course etc and not at school).

Change of Contact Details

At any time throughout the year, if addresses or pone numbers change for family members or your emergency contact people, please let us know ASAP so that we always have the most up to date information available. This also applies in regards to the diagnosis of new medical conditions too.

SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS FOR 2022

The School Contribution amount for 2022 will continue @ \$200 per annum (1st child), \$190 per annum (2nd child) and \$180 per annum for additional children. This will be added to your child's school account in the next few days and you will have an invoice/statement sent home with your eldest child. Payment of this contribution is really appreciated by our Board as this assists in providing all the wonderful EOTC activities, museum and art gallery visits, bus trips, visiting performers and swimming that your children participate in. Without these funds, we would be unable to provide the majority of these experiences for your children.

Payment of this School Contribution does not need to be made in full at one time as we totally understand the many outlays parents have. You are most welcome to pay like many other parents do via automatic payments eg each week/fortnight/month etc into our school bank account -

(03 0905 0914747 00 with references being your child's name and SC)

Or, you may also wish to pay using the **KINDO** system and make regular payments this way. Alternatively, if it suits you to pop into the **office and pay with cash or via EFTPOS**, you are also very welcome to do so, and a full receipt will then be emailed to you.

Once the School Contribution has been paid in full, a full receipt will be issued and you are able to then <u>claim 33% of this back</u> in your income tax return (this equates to \$66 for a \$200 payment). Payment of this year's School Contribution before 31 March will enable you to claim in this year's Income Tax Return.

Please give your consideration to payment of this School Contribution and how best your family can financially accommodate this.
