IMPORTANT - ABSENCES FROM SCHOOL

Over recent weeks there have been a lot of children away and our office staff have had to spend considerable time chasing parents up to find out where their children are as it is most important we can account for all children for their safety.

Please remember to <u>contact the school before 9am</u> if your child is going to be absent. It is important also to please <u>give the reason for your child's absence</u> so that this can be correctly coded on our Student Management System.

Our phone system has a <u>24hour answerphone</u> and therefore you are welcome to leave notification of your child's absence on there. Or.... If you wish to <u>email</u>, please email both your <u>child's class teacher and the office (office@grantsbraes.school.nz</u>) as well. Teachers sometimes don't always get an opportunity to open emails prior to 9am, or are sick or on release themselves, so may not get your email so it is important to notify the office as well. The PTA has been provided with a fundraising opportunity involving a consumer study being undertaken at the University of Otago.

What is the Aim of the ProjectThe Department of Food Science, University of Otago is carrying out consumer testing on milk which provides an opportunity for groups in the community to raise money for their organization. This project is part of a confidential research project involving a commercial entity and research collaborators from the University of Otago, Department of Food Science.

What Type of Participants are being sought?

We wish to include in this study, adults which are over 18 years of age. They should be in good health, and be willing to complete the entire study. Inclusion criteria:

- Adults over 18 years of age
- Be willing to drink milk samples
- Individuals with no sensitivity or allergies to dairy or dairy products

The PTA will be paid \$35 per volunteer and we must provide a minimum of 12 people to be paid.

We have two time slots available to book in our volunteers next Wednesday 1st December, either 6.45pm or 7.15pm.

The process is quick and streamlined (should be in and out within 45 minutes) and involves some screening questions and testing a small number of samples. This opportunity offers great return for effort
