ROAD SAFETY

I would like to remind parents of the importance of being good role-models when crossing the road. There have recently been a number of instances where parents have walked their children straight across Belford Street even though they were only 10 metres away from the crossing being run by the road patrol. It is important to use the road crossings (Belford Street and Larnach Road) when these are in operation, as these not only keep everyone safe, it also reinforces the importance of correct road safety in your children. Unfortunately, I am also getting reports of parents/caregivers parking illegally to pick up or drop off their children before and after school. This puts our students' safety at risk, breaks road rules and inconveniences local residents. Please ensure that you do not park over driveways and only use the disabled parking space if you have the correct permit, which needs to be displayed. Please note that due to the importance of this, offending vehicle registration plates may be forwarded to our School Liaison Police Officer to follow up.

School Drop Offs and Pick Ups

It is important that children are at school and settled in **before 9am each day.** Also - especially for our younger children, **please be at school by 3.00pm to collect them**. Our teachers often have to be away to meetings shortly after the bell rings, and are unable to supervise children in their classes, so it is important that parents/ caregivers are at school on time for pick-up.

SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS FOR 2022

The School Contribution amount for 2022 is **\$200 per annum (1st child)**, **\$190 per annum (2nd child) and \$180 per annum for additional children.**

Statements were sent home to all families last week with the eldest/only child, and, thank you so much to those families who have already paid this or started making payments.

Payment of this contribution is really appreciated by our Board as this assists in providing all the wonderful EOTC activities, museum and art gallery visits, bus trips, visiting performers and swimming that your children participate in. Without these funds, we would be unable to provide the majority of these experiences for your children.

Payment of this School Contribution does not need to be made in full at one time as we totally understand the many outlays parents have. You are most welcome to pay, like many other parents do, via **automatic payments** eg each week/fortnight/month etc into our school bank account -

(03 0905 0914747 00 with references being your child's name' and 'SC')

Or, you may also wish to pay using the **KINDO** system and make regular payments this way. Alternatively, if it suits you to pop into the **office and pay with cash or via EFTPOS**, you are also very welcome to do so, and a full receipt will then be emailed to you.

Once the School Contribution has been paid in full, a full receipt will be issued and you are able to then **claim 33% of this back** in your income tax return (this equates to \$66 for a \$200 payment). Payment of this year's School Contribution before 31 March will enable you to claim in this year's Income Tax Return.
