
Grant's Braes School

He was so impressed by the ākoka's knowledge and commented that he was able to work with them way above what he would normally plan for at their year level. I would like to thank Rebecca McKeever for organising this exciting opportunity. Also, Mataī and Tawa will travel to the Orokonui Sanctuary tomorrow as their trip had to be postponed earlier this term.

An application to the Bendigo Valley Trust was successful and our school has received \$5,000 from this most generous organisation. This money will go to support the Kā Manu swimming instruction. 
SCHOOL POLICY INFORMATION School Docs Access

The majority of the exhibition is dedicated to children's picture books written from the 1960s to the 1990s. In these books we see Māori stories brought vividly to life. They illustrate an important part of our shared history in Aotearoa, showing the value of children's pukapuka as a learning tool for the revitalisation of te reo Māori. The enthusiasm and dedication of writers and illustrators such as Dame Kāterina Mataira have paved the way for others to follow, keeping young and old minds alive and active in their knowledge of pūrākau, te reo and mātauraka Māori.


